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**2019 Standing Committees & Task Forces—please indicate the Committees/Task Forces you are interested in:**

- ARBITRATION COMMITTEE (MEMBERS WHO ARE BROKERS ONLY):** Shall consist of not less than seventeen (17) Members, including the Board of Directors and Broker Members. Any claims filed in accordance with the By-laws shall be heard by this Committee unless settled between the parties prior to a Hearing
- BY-LAW COMMITTEE:** Review and maintain the By-laws and recommend amendments which it feels will be of benefit to the Association and its Members.
- DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE:** Shall consist of not less than nine (9) Members all of whom shall have been Members of OREA for at least 3 years. They shall hold hearings to process disputes and matters referred by the Professional Standards Committee and discipline any Member in accordance to the By-laws.
- EDUCATION COMMITTEE:** Deals with the internal and external educational issues of the Association and its Members and makes recommendations pertaining to all educational matters relating to the Association, administers the Bursary and Scholarships and makes available such educational courses as may be appropriate and shall be responsible for the co-ordination, administration and overall operation of such courses.
- FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Regularly reviews the financial statements of the Association and makes recommendations concerning the financial operation of the Association, changes in levels of fees paid by Members, management of all assets and investments, preparation of an annual budget and such other financial matters that affect the financial position of the Association.
- MLS® RULES & REGULATIONS/STANDARD FORMS TASK FORCE:** Review and maintain the MLS® Rules and Regulations and recommend amendments which it feels will be of benefit to the Association and its Members. Reviews the standard forms and makes recommendations for any additions and/or deletions and amendments accordingly.
- NOMINATION TASK FORCE:** Shall receive completed nomination forms and nominate all positions where no nomination form has been received in accordance to the By-laws.
- POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE:** Create and develop relationships with local MP's by meeting on a regular basis to build a consensus with the City Council to encourage receptiveness of the real estate industry issues and achieve representation at the level of the Federal Government.
- PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS COMMITTEE:** Shall consist of not less than eleven (11) Members all of whom shall have been Members of OREA for at least 3 years. Upon receipt of a written complaint from any source the Professional Standards Committee may in their sole discretion proceed to take action as per the By-laws as outlined in ARTICLE 9.
- PUBLIC RELATIONS COMMITTEE:** Responsible for the publication, promotion and circulation of all information dealing with the Association and real estate industry generally and shall do everything possible to promote and enhance the image of the REALTORS®. Provide input and assistance for Association events.
- TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE:** Deals with the internal and external technology issues of the Association and its Members and makes recommendations pertaining to all technology matters relating to the delivery of MLS® and Membership services.
